







7 Mounting Options

Standard mounting options are shown below. Always test the effectiveness and application of each option before actual installation. In most cases, a good silicone adhesive is also recommended when mounting signs.




Double Faced Foam Tape

1/16" pressure sensitive foam tape. Best used in conjunction with silicone adhesive.




Double Faced Tape - Red Thin 2mil pressure sensitive tape. Great for flat, smooth surfaces.




Velcro Hook (Loop)

For fabric surfaces such as office workstations. Always test first.



Screw Holes - Torx 3/16" screw holes with optional 1.5" vandal resistant button torx.




Partition Hook Custom acrylic hooks available in black,


Magnetic Tape (Foil) 1/32" magnetic tape for steel surfaces or removable panels.





10 Changeable Message

Changeable window slot signs offer the advantage of quick in-house changes. Simply print out a new name or message on paper and insert it into the clear window opening. Any size or number of slots can be fabricated. Add your text to any sign below.




11 Restroom Signs

ADA restroom signs require raised lettering and Braille. The ISA symbol (wheelchair) should be added to the sign if the restroom is wheelchair accessible. Add your text to any sign below. Other sizes, styles and layouts are available.



12 California Restrooms

In addition to ADA wall signs (previous page), The State of California also requires a separate door sign. The sign must be 12" in size, a 1/4" thick and the background color must contrast with the door color. Single user restrooms are required to be unisex or gender neutral.



13 Directional - Overhead

Directional signs provide clear access and wayfinding information throughout a building. Signs can be wall mounted, flag mounted or suspended from the ceiling. Any number of panels can be made to suit your needs. Other sizes, styles and layouts are available.




14 | Informational Signs


15 Stair & Code Signs

Stair and code signs are not only required, but can also provide vital information in an emergency. Check your local and state regulations for any code variances to the federal ADA laws. Add your text to any sign below. Other sizes, styles and layouts are available.

Exit and evacuation signs help guide and direct people safely out of a building. Many require raised characters and Braille. Check your local and state regulations for any code variances to the federal ADA laws. Other sizes, styles and layouts are available.




17 ADA Floor Plan



20 ADA Sign Basics

Any sign that identifies a room, space or area is required to have raised characters and Braille. Below are the basic rules for such signs. Signs are required in both public access areas as well as all employee areas. Informational and directional signs do not require Braille or raised characters, however they are required to follow many of the other ADA rules. Fonts for signs that identify a room or space are required to be sans serif and shall not be italic, oblique, script, or decorative. Furthermore, lettering can not be too bold, condensed, or extended as illustrated below.

23 | Braille Requirements

There are many rules and guidelines when it comes to Braille. Proper size, shape, correct translation and placement ensure ease of reading and understanding.

Braille Regulations

- Braille shall be dome-shaped or rounded Not flat or pointy
- Braille shall be Grade 2 and be precisely sized and spaced
- Braille shall be 3/8" to 1/2" below last line of text
- Braille shall be grouped all together Not in two separate areas

 - Proper Name <u>G</u>eorge Jones <u>C</u>alifornia
 - Acronyms <u>U.S.A</u>.
 - Beginning of sentence Accessible restrooms...
 - A letter in a room number B320

24 ADA Pictograms

This chart depicts typical pictograms and their proper use. Pictograms used in identifying a room or space shall be within their own 6" high field. There is no specific rule on the height of the pictogram itself.




Required Pictograms:

6" high background field required. No text or Braille shall be located

within the pictogram field.









Room Sign Pictograms are not required, but are recommended. If used, a 6" high background field is required.




Miscellaneous Pictograms: Informational or directional. No field height requirement.








The proper spacing and size of different elements of an ADA sign is vital when someone is trying to read the sign visually or by touch. Characters, graphics, or Braille that are too close together or are too small make it hard to read or understand.



26 Character Height

Use this chart to determine the required character size of your ADA sign based on the mounting height of the sign and the likely viewing distance. The minimum character height will be indicated in the corresponding box below.



27 Sign Sizing Chart

The two tables below were developed to help you determine the proper size of your ADA sign based on lettering height and the number of characters and lines per sign. It is best to keep like sign types all the same size.

- 1 Select your letter size (We recommend a minimum of 3/4" letters).
- 2 Determine the number of characters and spaces in the longest line of text.
- 3 Determine the number of lines required.
- 4 Use the tables below to determine the sign size. See example to the right.

The sign to the left has 3/4" letters with <u>13</u> characters / spaces across and <u>3</u> lines of copy. Using the two tables below, the sign would have to be at least 6 x 9" to be ADA compliant.



28 | Mounting Guidelines

Below are general guidelines for mounting room signs with raised characters and Braille. The mounting height has a range of acceptable heights. Always check with your state and local codes as well as your building inspector before installing signs.



- If there is not enough space on the latch side, then the sign can be mounted on the nearest adjacent wall.
- The minimum mounting height is 48" to the baseline of the lowest line in the sign.
- The maximum mounting height is 60" to the baseline of the highest line in the sign.
- Tactile characters on the sign shall be centered within an minimum 18 x 18" clear floor space.
